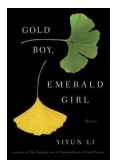
Habit of a Foreign Sky (2010)

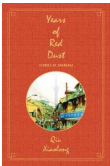

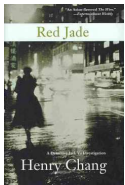

Red Jade: a Detective Jack Yu Investigation (2010)

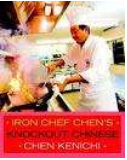
